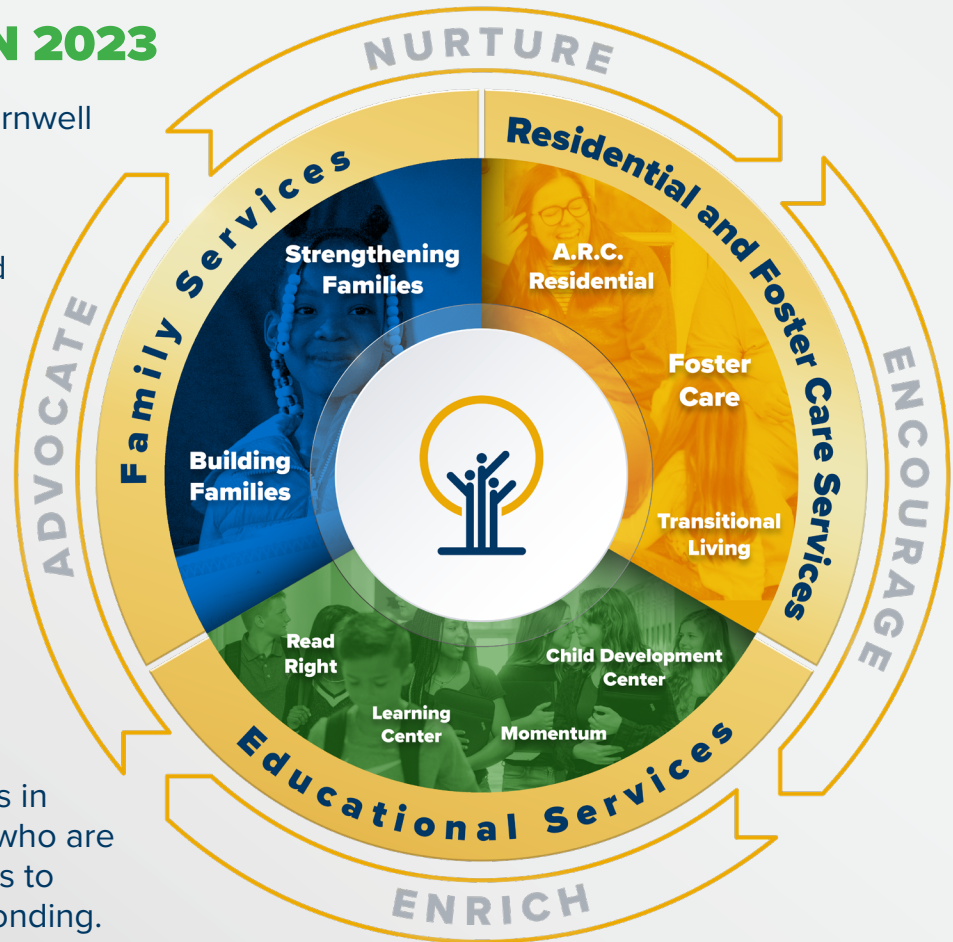
2,030 children and families served in 2023 across Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina!

WHO WE ARE 

Founded in 1875, Thornwell's vision is to see hopeful, healthy, and empowered children and families fulfilling their God-given potential. **As a Christian ministry, our mission is to provide safe and nurturing environments where we educate, equip, and support children and families to thrive.**

THORNWELL'S IMPACT IN 2023

- **83 children** were placed in loving Thornwell foster homes, including **17 teens**.
- **50 ARC Residential** and **Transitional Living** participants served through **989 therapy sessions** – including individual, group, art, and horse-assisted therapy.
- **1,208 children and family members** served across Florida, Georgia, and South Carolina through the **Building Families** program.
- **146% growth rate** in the number of infants through 4K program students served in **Child Development Center**.
- **85.5% graduation rate** for participants in the **Strengthening Families** program who are now equipped with skills and resources to support healthy communication and bonding.
- **151 students** experienced academic gains through **Read Right, Momentum Summer Camp, and Learning Center Tutoring**.
- **481 volunteers gave 2,930 hours** to help children and families served by Thornwell.
